CURRICULUM



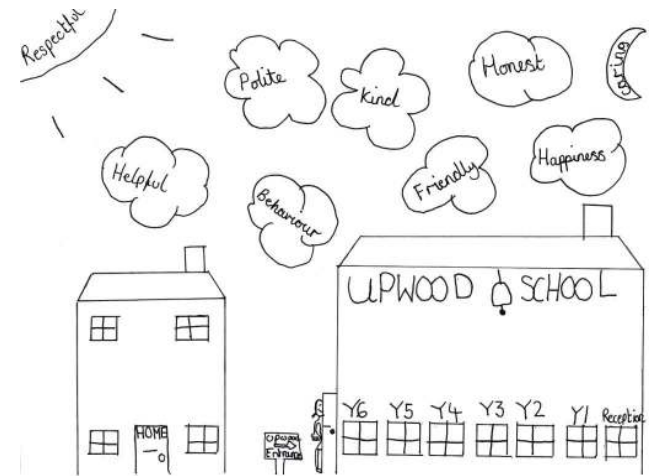


HOME-SCHOOL AGREEMENT
