Statutory Assessment Tests

Children are assessed in each year of their schooling at Upwood Primary in order to monitor their progress, celebrate achievement and target areas for development.

During the month of May, children in Years 2 and 6 undertake Statutory Assessment Tests, commonly known as 'SATs'. Year 6 testing will be completed during the week beginning 12th May. We would ask Year 6 parents/carers to encourage your child(ren) to:

- have early nights;
- eat a good breakfast before school;
- ensure they have several drinks to bring to school;
- provide them with opportunities to relax after school.

Year 5 will be taught in the hall during this time. Year 2 assessments are spread over a longer period of time, but many are completed during the month of May.

Each and every pupil has given their best effort over the last year, working hard to achieve their best across the curriculum. We hope that every child has the opportunity to shine and reap the rewards of all their hard work.

May Day Celebrations

On 1st May, we held our annual May Day festivities, which are meant to celebrate the arrival of finer weather! Unfortunately, due to the amount of rain we received on May Day, the festivities were relocated indoors. Many parents and carers helped to move the chairs, which was much appreciated. This year, Upwood pupils performed 'Dances From Around the World' to family and friends, including dances from India, Ireland and France.
