Christmas Tickets – Reminder

The children and staff are working very hard towards the Christmas performances which will involve a Year 6 play and items of entertainment from each class. The dates of the performances are Wednesday 10th December and Thursday 11th December, 6.00pm – 7.00pm; please note the start time.

Children are allowed on site from 5.30pm onwards and need to be taken to their key stage entrance; your child only will enter the entrance and will proceed to their classroom where they will be supervised by their class teacher and a member of the support staff. If you are staying for the performance you must have a ticket for the night you are attending. Entrance will be via the main school entrance and doors will open from 5.30pm where two members of staff will be present to collect tickets. Tickets will be sent out to parents/carers the week beginning 2nd December.

All families will be issued with 2 tickets for one performance or one ticket for each performance. Unfortunately, we cannot issue more than 2 tickets per family. If there are spare tickets available, an extra ticket will be offered to Year 6 parents/carers as their last Christmas performance. If you plan not to use both tickets, please do not hand your ticket to another family; please return the ticket to the School Office for us to redistribute. Thank you for your co-operation with this.
